Applicant

- ◆ Must be an Active member of CCFCC/NVICA Junior Chapter

Application Process

- ◆ Applicant must supply their professional resumé with letter(s) of reference
- ◆ Applicant must supply a written letter detailing what project they wish to undertake
- ◆ Applicant must attend a personal interview with the Bursary and Scholarship Selection Committee

Selection of Recipient

- ◆ The Education director of CCFCC/NVICA shall chair a Bursary Scholarship Committee made up of Active and Associate members of CCFCC/NVICA
- ◆ All applicants for this scholarship will be considered

Award of Bursary

- ◆ Recipient will be awarded the scholarship at; a monthly general meeting of CCFCC/NVICA , the annual Installation Dinner and again at the fall fund raising event
- ◆ All decisions by the Education Committee and Centennial Foodservice are final

Application must include the following to be considered:

- ***A personal professional resumé***
- ***A detailed letter stating what project you would like to undertake***
- ***A detailed account of expenses to be encountered***
- ***A detailed letter explaining what benefit this will be to your culinary career***
- ***A letter or reverence from your employer attesting to your job performance (if you are self employed a letter from yourself will suffice)***
- ***Letter(s) of personal reference***
