

**PROPOSED FORMAT FOR THE SELECTION OF THE NORTH VANCOUVER ISLAND CHEF'S ASSOCIATION BURSARY & SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS, SPONSORED BY CENTENNIAL FOODSERVICE.**

**CRITERIA:**

**INSTITUTION:**

- The post secondary college must have a kitchen of commercial standards.
- The teacher/instructor must hold a valid certificate of Cooking with Journey person status.
- The school must use the approved B.C. Professional Cook Training curriculum for levels I, II, and III.
- The course must contain a minimum of 70% practical.

**APPLICANT:**

- Must be a member of the North Vancouver Island Chef's Association's Junior Chapter.
- Must be enrolled within the 3<sup>rd</sup> Level course of the Professional Cook Training Program at an accredited Post Secondary Institution within the NVICA region.
- Must not be an apprentice or Journey person in cooking.

**APPLICATION:**

- Complete the necessary application form(s).
- Provide a letter stating why they think they should be chosen for the bursary and also stating what their cooking aspirations are for the future.
- Provide a letter of reference that attests to the applicant's character.
- All applicants due by May 1st

**SELECTION OF RECIPIENT:**

- The Education Director of the NVICA shall chair a Bursary Scholarship Committee made up of Active, Associate and junior members of the NVICA.
- All applicants for this Bursary will be reviewed by the Bursary Selection Committee and narrowed down to three applicants.
- The Vice-President of Centennial Foodservice will review the final applications and select the recipient with a non-bias opinion.
- Selection will be final and cannot be appealed.
- The Bursary will be awarded at the annual installation dinner/ceremony, usually held in June.

**AWARD OF BURSARY:**

- The cheque and plaque, in the amount of the Bursary, will be given upon receipt of confirmation (photocopy of the completed registration form) that the student has enrolled in a Post Secondary Professional Cook Training Program.
- The recipient must be willing to be in attendance for at least one of the following NVICA events;
  - i) the NVICA installation dinner-normally held in June
  - ii) the fall fundraising banquet
  - iii) At other major functions of the NVICA
- Printed plaque will state: NORTH VANCOUVER ISLAND CHEF'S ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP-BURSARY \$500.00 SPONSORED BY CENTENNIAL FOODSERVICE
- All decisions by the Education Committee and Centennial Foodservice are final.
