Post Secondary Institution Bursaries



Institution

- must have a kitchen of commercial standards
- Instructor(s) must hold a valid journeyman certification
- must use approved BC curricula for Levels I, II, III
- course must contain a minimum of 70 % practical

Applicant

- must be enrolled in a Culinary Arts program at an accredited institution within the NVICA region
- must be a junior member of the NVICA. Each applicant will be evaluated on a simple point system as follows:
 - 5 points awarded for each meeting attended,
 - 10 points awarded for volunteering for a fund-raising event,
 - 10 points awarded for volunteering for a committee, or planning an event or workshop.The applicant(s) with the highest number of points will be awarded a bursary, but a minimum of 25 points will be required.

Application Process

- application form must be completed,
- applicant will write a letter stating why they believe they should be chosen for the bursary, and their aspirations for the future,
- applicant will provide a letter of character reference.(not from a family member),
- applicant will provide a letter of evaluation from an instructor,
- applications are due by April 30.

Selection of Recipient

- the NVICA shall appoint a committee formed of active, associate, and junior members each year to review the applications and decide upon the recipient(s)
- the committee's decision(s) shall be based on the above criteria, and are final.

Award of Bursary

- a cheque in the amount of the award will be presented at the NVICA installation dinner, usually held in June. Recipients are encouraged to attend.
